



Cut and Fold

1. Cut along the black dashed line.



2. With the blank side up, fold along the red dashed lines so that all four corners meet in the center, forming an even smaller square.



3. Turn over and fold the top corner to the center along the blue dashed line and repeat with the other three corners.



4. Fold in half, unfold, and repeat in the other direction.



5. Place a pointer finger or thumb into each pocket and you're ready to play.
